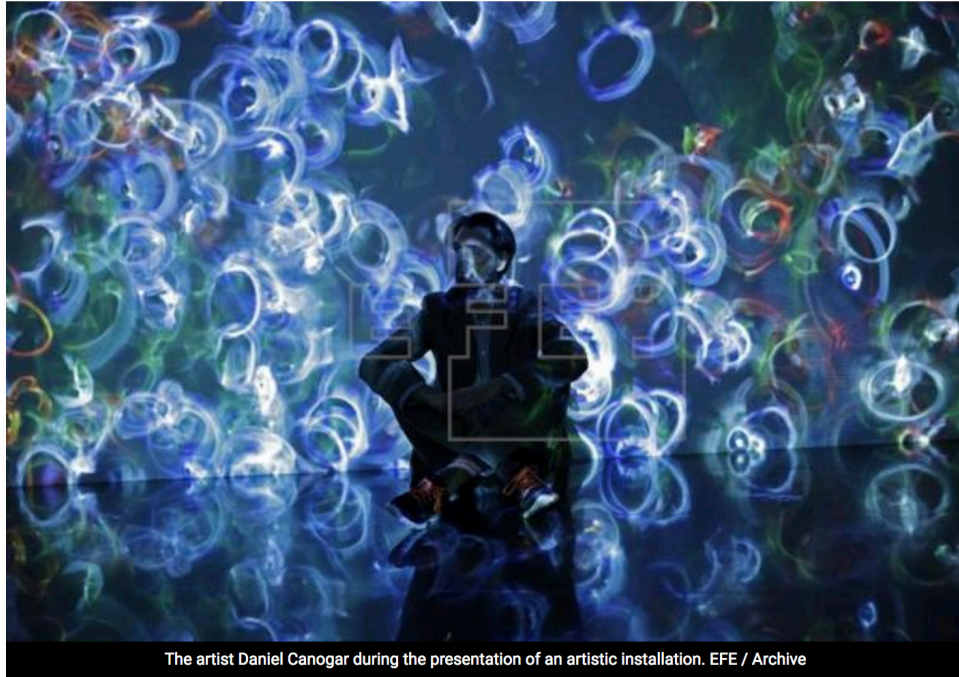

The Spanish artist Daniel Canogar will present his show "Asalto London" at the Westminster City Hall within the London Lumière event, which will be held in the British capital from January 18 to 21.

The "show" of Canogar will be staged in the aforementioned building in the center of the British capital and will combine the intervention of the public with an audiovisual show.

Canogar, specializing in outdoor projects involving people, will help residents and building workers "climb" Westminster City Hall one after the other, until they finally reach the ceiling.

The London Lumière, in its second edition, will host more than fifty artists who will represent their works throughout the London city, in such emblematic places as the King's Cross station, in Regent Street or in Westminster Abbey.

The artists will try to transform the streets and buildings of the city into an integrating exhibition of night art, through games of lights and sound, whose entrance is free.

It is the most important festival of lights in the United Kingdom and attracted, in its first edition in London in 2016, more than one million visitors.

The objective of the event is for pedestrians to enjoy the streets of London, as if they were an art gallery without walls, during their four nights.
